# **Primary Schools Programme**


- **Duration**: 3 classroom sessions.
- **Structure**: Post-primary students facilitate the roundtables with minimal teacher workload.
- Implementation: Strengthens links with local postprimary schools, supports 1st-year transition, & develops leadership skills for all.
- Fully Funded\*: All training & materials are provided at no cost to schools.
